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LSK SCHOLARSHIP

Qualifications and Guidelines

Woman's Missionary Union of Virginia (WMUV) has established a scholarship for one outstanding Girls in Action (GA) or Children in Action (CiA) to attend the summer camping program at CrossRoads Camp and Conference Center each year. This scholarship is awarded in memory of Kristen and Katie Lisk, two of Virginia's outstanding GAs who loved Girls in Action camp.

Scholarship shall be awarded to an outstanding GA or CiA who attends a church affiliated with the Baptist General Association of Virginia (BGAV). Applicants are eligible to receive the Lisk Scholarship one time only.

Qualifications

- Must be a girl in grades four through six.
- Must actively attend Girls in Action (GA) or Children in Action (CiA).
- Should exhibit Christian leadership, be a positive role model among peers, and demonstrate a missions lifestyle.
- Applicant must be recommended by the GA leader/director or association of the local church which she attends.
- Applicant must meet the requirements for summer campers at CrossRoads.

Selection Guidelines

- Members of the WMUV Children's Ministry Council will review and select the Scholarship recipient.
- Scholarship recipient will be sent a letter of confirmation by March 1, along with a health form and camp brochure upon approval.
- An "Outstanding GA" certificate will be awarded either through the mail, at the Mom and Me Camp or at the WMUV Annual Meeting.
- Availability of scholarships will be limited to the funds provided by interest earned, donations, of not more than 15% of unrestricted funds.
- Scholarship approval is subject to available space at CrossRoads.
- WMUV Children's Educational Consultant will notify CrossRoads Camp and Conference Center of the scholarship recipient.
- The scholarship recipient will register for camp for the week of her choice and mark the camp registration form "Lisk Scholarship." No funds should be paid with the registration form.
- Recipient may be asked to give a presentation at Mom and Me Camp, WMUV Annual Meeting, or another WMUV event.

Application Process

Leader:

- Complete Application Form and instruct applicant to write mandatory essay (instructions for applicant are below).
- There is no limitation to the number of girls a church may nominate.
- Secure written recommendations from two Church Leaders.
- Mail all required information to Outstanding GA, WMU of Virginia, P. O. Box 8435, Richmond, VA 23226.
- Application *must be received by **February 1.***

Applicant:

- Applicant must write an essay about her involvement in GA/CiA, specifying why GA/CiA is important to her, listing what missions and ministries she has been involved in and describing the ones which were most meaningful to her and why.

AFTER CAMP

Applicant will be asked to write a one page reflection summary describing why her camp experience, how the year as Outstanding GA has been meaningful to her, and what she has learned through her experiences. This shall be mailed to Lisk Camper Scholarship, WMUV, PO Box 8435, Richmond, VA 23226. Applicant may be asked to present this reflection summary at the WMUV Annual Meeting

Candidate shall be endorsed by the Board of Trustees of WMUV.
